DESCRIPTION

Abricon initially carried out a Phase 1 ESA to assist the company to obtain an IPPC authorisation for its operating processes, by establishing a baseline contamination statement as part of the Site Report required to submit a permit application. Subsequently Abricon provided assistance to the client to carry out a review of BAT (Best Available Techniques) applied at the site to minimise releases to all three environmental media (again to support the IPPC application). Total value of work required was of the order of £10,000.
